confirms the right to use the waters of THE ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of THE PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 3.45 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, Page 3. The date of priority is 1880.

The use is limited to 0.069 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.029 CFS FROM DIVERSION 1 AND 0.04 CFS FROM DIVERSION 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; DIVERSION 1 - 2120 FEET SOUTH AND 690 FEET WEST; DIVERSION 2 - 2350 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 32.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.45 ACRES 2.00 ACRES SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 16, 1984, and together with Certificate 52558, supersedes Certificate 15828, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
