CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THE CITY OF ROSEBURG
900 SOUTHEAST DOUGLAS AVENUE
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 1.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41139. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1976. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 24, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1380 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.9
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
