## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD G. KELLER 25900 FAIRVIEW AVENUE HAYWARD, CALIFORNIA 94542

confirms the right to use the waters of LARSON CREEK (AKA LARKIN CREEK) AND WATERCRESS RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6680, tributaries of WILLIAMSON RIVER, for IRRIGATING 23.0 ACRES, RECREATION, AND FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit 42133. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1977. This right is limited to 0.59 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.57 CFS FROM LARSON CREEK FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.02 CFS FROM LARSON CREEK AND WATERCRESS RESERVOIR FOR FISH CULTURE AND RECREATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 34 S, R 7 E, W.M.; 1640 FEET NORTH AND 2050 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 13.4 ACRES, FISH CULTURE, AND RECREATION NW 1/4 SE 1/4 9.6 ACRES SECTION 11

TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
