confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of LARKIN CREEK (AKA LARSON CREEK), for IRRIGATING 66.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41909. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1977. This right is limited to 1.66 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 34 S, R 7 E, W.M.; 350 FEET NORTH AND 1200 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
