CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENNIS AND SHERI WALTMAN
226 HUMPHREY LANE
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of CHENEY CREEK, a tributary of THE APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 7.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1884.

The use is limited to 0.118 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed 0.118 cubic foot per second and that the quantity of water diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 406 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.0 ACRES
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled.

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 18, 1988, and together with Certificate 57582, supersedes Certificate 16274, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
