CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT
SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of the SILETZ RIVER, a tributary of SILETZ BAY, in the MID-COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE SILETZ RIVER FROM THE U.S.G.S. GAGE 14-3055 AT STREAM MILE 42.6 (SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 10 S, R 10 W, W.M.) TO THE MOUTH OF THE SILETZ RIVER.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JULY 12, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 15	150
OCT 16- MAY 31	200
JUN 1 - JUN 30	135
JUL 1 - SEP 30	100

This instream water right shall not affect domestic or livestock uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.



The following condition shall remain in effect until June 9, 1999, or until the Seal Rock Water District enters into a Regional Water Supply Authority, which ever comes first.

The use of up to 0.71 cubic feet per second of water by the Seal Rock Water District under permit number 40277 shall not be affected by regulation for this instream water right if:

1. The District limits the number of active service connections to the number in existence on January 1, 1992, with the addition only of those 30 connections described in Findings of Fact 27-30, recorded in Special Order Book Volume 46, page 286 and 287;
2. The District enforces the standby water use curtailment procedures adopted by the District on January 9, 1992, referenced in the Special Order Book Volume 46, page 282; and
3. The District activates and diligently enforces its adopted water use curtailment procedures whenever notified by the watermaster that streamflows in the Siletz River are inadequate to meet the levels prescribed in this instream water right and continues such enforcement until notified by the watermaster that adequate streamflows are available to meet this instream water right.
