CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF SILETZ INDIANS
P.O. BOX 549
SILETZ, OREGON 97380

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING CREEK, a tributary of SILETZ RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 24825. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1952. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 10 S, R 8 W, W.M.; N 19° W, 3445 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 43777, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 8, 1992, approving Transfer Application 6681.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
