CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the WILLIAMS CREEK BASIN for of IRRIGATING 7.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9748. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1981. This right is limited to 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 38 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 500 FEET NORTH AND 3300 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.5 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
