CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.G. BUCHANAN BOX S IMNAHA, OREGON 97828

confirms the right to use the waters of IMNAHA RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 1.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 41269. The date of priority is DECEMBER 3, 1976. This right is limited to 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 1 N, R 48 E, W.M.; 1350 FEET NORTH AND 960 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.2 ACRE SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 ACRE SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 ACRE SECTION 16 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
