This right was perfected under Permit 47270. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 12, 1981. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 7 S, R 42 E, W.M.; 2085 FEET SOUTH AND 1155 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
