CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND PHILLIPS
JACKSONVILLE, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of APLEGATE RIVER, for DOMESTIC, STOCK AND IRRIGATION OF 6.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1908.

The use is limited to 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 40 S, R 2 W, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) 6.1 ACRES
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 32967, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on SEPTEMBER 8, 1992.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
