CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of APPLIGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1897.

The use is limited to 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the PLACE OF USE as corrected from the Order of the Circuit Court for JACKSON County entered MARCH 14, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 40386.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
