CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARCHIE C. PIERCE 99 PIERCE HEIGHTS MEDFORD, OREGON 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of RED BLANKET CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 40.35 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 4318. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 25, 1919. The right is limited to not more than 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source and shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 32 S, R 3 E, W.M.; 780 FEET NORTH AND 1300 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.65 ACRES SECTION 27

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 10.0 ACRES NE 1/4 NW 1/4 24.7 ACRES

SECTION 34

TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 27, 1987, and together with Certificate 56482, supersedes Certificate 47807, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
