## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMINA CREEK, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER, for MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC FISH FACILITY.

This right was perfected under Permit 15022. The date of priority is JUNE 13, 1941. This right is limited to 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{3}$  SE $\frac{1}{3}$ , AS PROJECTED WITHIN BRANSON DLC 43, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 2050 FEET NORTH AND 520 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 41795, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 6752.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
