CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C. R. AND/OR M. J. OYERLY

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the BEAR CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATING 0.71 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8531. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1979. This right is limited to 0.009 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 38 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 380 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.70 ACRE
SECTION 13

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.01 ACRE
SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
