CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the IRRIGATION OF 0.9 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 49772. The date of priority is JULY 25, 1986. This right is limited to 0.011 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 17, T 22 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND 450 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.9 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
