CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MONROE UNION HIGH SCHOOL, U.H. NO.1

confirms the right to use the waters of THE LONG TOM RIVER, a tributary of THE WILLAMETTE RIVER, for BUILDING HEATING AND COOLING.

This right was perfected under Permit 50714. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1989. This right is limited to 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 14 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 930.7 FEET NORTH AND 4008.2 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
