CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD S. HINOJOSA BOX 22 QUINES CREEK ROAD AZALEA, OREGON 97410

confirms the right to use the waters of QUINES CREEK, a tributary of COW CREEK, for IRRIGATING 12.2 ACRES AND STOCK WATER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 1. The date of priority is JULY 25, 1894.

The use is limited to 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, if available at the old point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1650 FEET NORTH AND 950 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) in case of rotation for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 12.2 ACRES AND STOCK SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 29, 1978 and supersedes Certificate 9614, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
