CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARIAN M. DOLE  
MEDFORD, OREGON 97051

confirms the right to use the waters of ANDERSON CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 8.9 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1857.

The use is limited to 0.121 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 1 W, W.M.; BALDWIN DITCH - 425 FEET SOUTH AND 320 FEET WEST FROM E CORNER OF SECTION 33.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$             3.0 ACRES  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$             5.9 ACRES  
SECTION 34  
TOWNSHIP 38, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 60562, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 12, 1992, approving Transfer Application 6612.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
