CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOE GONSALVES 5680 WESTSIDE RD CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of CHOKE CHERRY CREEK, a tributary of WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 33516. The date of priority is APRIL 23, 1968. This right is limited to 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 740 FEET NORTH AND 630 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.0 ACRES
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 67069.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
