CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN A. LIDELL, JR.
ROUTE 1, BOX 255
TERREBONNE, OREGON 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 12 in the DESCHUTES BASIN for IRRIGATING 59.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4396. The date of priority is APRIL 15, 1969. This right is limited to 0.75 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE OLD POINTS OF APPROPRIATION - (WELLS 5, 6, AND 11), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 550 FEET SOUTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	0.1 ACRE
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	9.7 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	32.7 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	2.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	11.4 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	1.1 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.6 ACRES

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

the pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.
