CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of HATCH-SANDER-WALLACE SLOUGH, a tributary of THE NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 25.8 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 45426. The date of priority is MARCH 25, 1980. This right is limited to 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 9 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 1160 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
