CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the MALHEUR RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 30.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9198. The date of priority is JANUARY 1981. This right is limited to 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW% SW%, SECTION 17, T 19 S, R 44 E, W.M.; 2700 FEET SOUTH AND 970 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
