CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRANT R. JONES
1653 JUMP OFF JOE CREEK ROAD
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of JUMP OFF JOE CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT NO. R-8143, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44915. The date of priority is JULY 20, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 34 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 370 FEET NORTH AND 330 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre from direct flow, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.4 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
