CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

UPPER COW CREEK COMMUNITY CENTER
16143 UPPER COW CREEK ROAD
AZALEA, OREGON 97410

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE IN A COMMUNITY HALL.

This right was perfected under Permit 45248. The date of priority is MARCH 11, 1980. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 31 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 420 FEET NORTH AND 3000 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 31 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
