CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS S. DUNCAN  
961 TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY  
COTTAGE GROVE, OREGON 97424

confirms the right to use the waters of PHEASANT CREEK, a tributary of PASS CREEK, for IRRIGATING 9.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44994. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1980. This right is limited to 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 21 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1900 FEET NORTH AND 1310 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 9.2 ACRES  
SECTION 19  
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
