CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD KELLY

confirms the right to use the waters of CHAMPAGNE CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46936. The date of priority is JULY 22, 1982. This right is limited to 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47, SECTION 12, T 27 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 1220 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
