confirms the right to use the waters of FALL RIVER, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51220. The date of priority is JANUARY 25, 1991. This right is limited to 17.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 20 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 340 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be maintained and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
