## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARY W. EATON 155 WESTWOOD ASHLAND, OR 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of NEIL CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATING 0.2 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1854.

The use is limited to 0.002 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN TAYLOR DLC 41, SECTION 19, T 39 S, R 2 E, W.M.; 410 FEET SOUTH AND 660 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.2 ACRE AS PROJECTED WITHIN TAYLOR DLC 41 SECTION 19 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 2, 1984, and together with Certificate 52559, supersedes Certificate 46186, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
