CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THUNDER RIVER CORPORATION
P.O. BOX 272
NEWBERG, OREGON 97132

confirms the right to use the waters of WALL CREEK, a tributary of TRAIL CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 1.2 ACRES AND OPERATION OF A HYDRAULIC RAM PUMP.

This right was perfected under Permit 45303. The date of priority is JANUARY 7, 1980. This right is limited to 0.028 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.008 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.02 CFS FOR OPERATION OF THE RAM or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 33 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1 - 700 FEET NORTH AND 820 FEET EAST, 2 - 350 FEET NORTH AND 1100 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.2 ACRES AND HYDRAULIC RAM
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
