CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND J. SATTER

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 34.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10917. The date of priority is MARCH 29, 1988. This right is limited to 0.43 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 79, SECTION 16, T 7 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 30 FEET SOUTH AND 673 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water under the terms of this certificate has been determined to have the potential to cause substantial interference with surface water in the Little Pudding River or its tributaries. Whenever substantial interference exists with senior surface water users, or a minimum stream flow or instream water right with a senior priority date, this use shall be controlled along with junior surface water users.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4	4.2 ACRES
SECTION 16	
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.	

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
