## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL J. AND CAROL A. BRAZEAL HC 64, BOX 76 LAKEVIEW, OREGON 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the THOMAS CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATING 2.88 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10913. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1988. This right is limited to 0.036 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) SECTION 4, T 39 S, R 20 E, W.M.; SOUTH 52 DEGREES 14 MINUTES WEST 1116.30 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) 2.88 ACRES SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to supply all prior rights.
