CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SUTHERLIN CREEK, a tributary of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 50265. The date of priority is OCTOBER 15, 1987. This right is limited to 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION 14, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1900 FEET NORTH AND 1785 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.27 ACRE
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.73 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
