CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EASTWOOD SCHOOL 2550 SE WALDON STREET ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of DEER CREEK, in AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR, for WILDLIFE HABITAT.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11246. The date of priority is JULY 24, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 0.60 acre-foot.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 20 TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Use under this certificate is limited to the reservoir area. This certificate does not provide for appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, storage of water in the reservoir shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring all incoming natural flows and outflows from the reservoir or passing all incoming natural flows. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
