CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALBERTINA P. SOUZA  
739 ELK CREEK ROAD  
TRAIL, OREGON 97541

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of THE ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 1.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1894.

The use is limited to 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion (Johnson Brothers Ditch).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 1570 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.8 ACRES  
SECTION 30  
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 3, 1990, and together with Certificate 64428, supersedes Certificate 63764, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
