CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That A. J. BISHOP

of Newberg, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Mill Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 369; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

.015 cubic foot per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

A description of the land in connection with which said right has been decreed is as follows:

Five tenths acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, five tenths acre in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 2 W.W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
