CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EUGENE AND IVY VAN LEEUWEN
37793 GILKEY ROAD
SCIO, OREGON 97374

confirms the right to use the waters of THOMAS CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATING 72.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42758. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1977. This right is limited to 0.9 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 15, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 6200 FEET NORTH AND 3201 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC 65.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 9.9 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65

LOT 8 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) 1.6 ACRES
SECTION 15

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 25.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.1 ACRE
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 32.5 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 20, 1990, and supersedes Certificate 54435, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
