### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF VETERAN'S AFFAIRS 700 SUMMER ST. NE SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of the TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 24.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20441. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1951. This right is limited to 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NO AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

# NW NE NE 13.0 ACRES NE NW 11.9 ACRES ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN NOWLAND DLC 67 SECTION 21 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm that portion of the water right described in an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 24, 1989, approving Transfer 6258, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on the ------ day of February, 1993, and together with Certificate 63837 supersedes Certificate 23559.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
