confirms the right to use the waters of BURNT CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-9253, a tributary of KEENE CREEK, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 48168. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1983. This right is limited to 0.001 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 39 S, R 3 E, W.M.; 2600 FEET NORTH AND 2700 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
