CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MARION GEORGE

of Newberg, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek for the purpose of Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 369; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from that said right exists by virtue of ownership of land riparian to said stream, and is held in common with the rights of other riparian owners as determined by said decree; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed amount which may be reasonably and beneficially used for said purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

A description of the land in connection with which said right has been decreed, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, T. 3 S. R. 2 W. W. M. Beginning at a point twenty-two and fifty seven and 1/2 hundredths chains North and eight chains East, (Var. 21 degrees East,) of the intersection of the section line between Sections Nineteen and Twenty, said Township and Range, and the South Line of said Donation Land Claim; running thence East, (Var. 21 degrees East,) 12.80 chains; thence North 2.35 chains; thence West (Var. 21 degrees E.,) 12.80 chains, and thence South 2.35 chains to the place of beginning, containing 3 acres, more or less.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
