that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

amount which may be reasonably and beneficially used for said purpose;

Notification No. 1477; Township 3 Scuth, Range 2 West of the Willsmette Meridian in Yamhill County, State of Oregon; thence South 19 chains and 46 feet; thence East 10 chains; thouce North 19 chains and 46 feet; thence West 10 chains to place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
