and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume , at page 369 ; that the priority .8 of the right thereby confirmed cates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> Beginning at a point 29 rods and 14.7 feet south of the northwest corner of a certain tract of land sold and deeded to Elisha Smith by Samual Longley and Ellen H. Longley, his wife, which said deed is of record at page 571 in book 29 of the record of deeds in and for said county, and running thence east 91 and 1/5 rods, to east line of said tract, thence south 7 rods and 2.2 feet to line of Everest lands thence west 3 and 1/5 rods to east line of said claim thence south on said east line to north line of the O. & C.R.R. (formerly P & W V R R ) right of way, thence southwesterly alond said railroad right of way to a point 9 and 3/4 rods north of the southwest corner lands formerly owned by one A.T.Blair, and thence north to place of beginning, save and except from the operation of this deed 38/100 of an acre of the said premises now owned by the SouthernPacific Railroad Company, and described in decree as recorded at page 2, 3 and 4 of volume 12 of the Journal of the Circuit Court for the County of Yamhill and State of Oregon, and containing twenty-three acres of land be the same more or less. Tract No. 2, beginning at a stone in County road 21 rods and 1.6 feet south of the northwest corner of a tract of land sold and deeded to Elisha Smith by Samuel Longley and Ellen H. Longley, his wife; said deed being recorded at page 371 in book 29 of the record of deeds for said county, and running thence east 91 and 1/5 rods to stone, thence south 8 rods and 12.7 feet to stone, thence west 91 and 1/5 rods to stone, in County road, and thence north 8 rods and 12 and 7/10 feet to place of beginning, and containing

five acres of land, be the same more or less.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. WITNESS the signature of the State Engineer,
