CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 88.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11036. The dates of priority are DECEMBER 21, 1987, FOR 0.78 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND FEBRUARY 1, 1988, FOR 0.33 CFS. This right is limited to 1.1 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 7 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 480 FEET NORTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 5

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE AND GROUND WATER rights of others.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
