CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLIFFORD HERR  
9551 SELAH SPRINGS ROAD  
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 31.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11076. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1990. This right is limited to 0.4 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 61, SECTION 13, T 7 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 350 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF NE 1/4 SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4            2.1 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 61

SW 1/4 SE 1/4            8.6 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 88  
SECTION 12

NW 1/4 NE 1/4            14.7 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 88

NE 1/4 NW 1/4            6.2 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 61  
SECTION 13

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

THE DIRECTOR MAY REQUIRE WATER LEVEL OR PUMP TEST RESULTS EVERY TEN YEARS.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.
