CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHARLES A. & ALICE A. KEENEY

of Newberg, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Mill Creek

for the purpose of Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 369; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from that said right exists by virtue of ownership of land riparian to said stream, and is held in common with the rights of other riparian owners as determined by said decree;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

amount which may be reasonably and beneficially used for said purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

A description of the land in connection with which said right has been decreed, is as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the east boundary line of Joseph B. Rogers and wife, D.L.C. No. 55, Not. 1473, in T. Three (3) South of Range Two (2) West of the Willamette Meridian, in Yamhill County, Oregon and at a point 29.02 chains South 24' West of the Northeast corner of said claim, being the southeast corner of the Friends Cemetery; thence west 10.84 chains to a stake in center of county road leading from Newberg to Wynooski landing; thence south 27 degrees east along center of said road 7.14 chains to stone 6 x 6 x 8 inches on northwest corner of a tract sold by F. S. Cattle to Haworth from which an oak 12 in. in diameter bears north 60 degrees 30' east 57 1/2 links; thence east 7.60 chains to a stone 12 x 8 x 6 in. on east boundary of said Rogers claims and northeast corner of land sold to Haworth from which an oak 14 in. in diameter bears north 33 degrees 45' west 52 links and another oak 12 in. in diameter bears south 45 degrees West 31 links; thence north 24' east on east boundary of said claim (sin and 36/100) 6.36 chains to stake and place of beginning containing 6.86 acres of land more or less, save and except therefrom a strip eight (8) feet wide off of the north end of said premises heretofore deeded to the city of Newberg for a right of way to Cemetery.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
