confirms the right to store the waters of NORTH FORK ASH CREEK, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, in THREE DUCK LAKES, appropriated under Permit 49563, for DUCK ATTRACTION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10589. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1985. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 4.4 acre-feet, being 1.8 AF IN DUCK LAKE 1; 1.4 AF IN DUCK LAKE 2, and 1.2 AF IN DUCK LAKE 3.

Water is stored annually during the non-irrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The DUCK LAKES are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4        DUCK LAKE 1  
SE 1/4 NE 1/4        DUCK LAKES 2 AND 3  
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44  
SECTION 3  
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
