CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK ASH CREEK AND THREE DUCK LAKES, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10589, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for MAINTENANCE OF THREE DUCK LAKES AND DUCK ATTRACTION.

This right was perfected under Permit 49563. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1985. This right is limited to 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 3, T 8 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 720 FEET SOUTH AND 680 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF DLC 43.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NE 1/4
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive uses.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
