CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That WILLIAM PERKINS

of Newberg, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek for the purpose of Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 369; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

.01 cubic foot per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Being a part of the D.D. Diskins D.L.C. in Township three, South, Range two west of the Willamette Meridian in Yamhill County and State of Oregon and beginning at the Southeast corner of a tract of land deeded by Marie K. Evans and Eli-Evans to William Perkins; Thence West 306.9 feet, thence North 10.75 chains; thence East 306.9 feet, thence South 10.75 chains to place of beginning containing 5 acres, more or less.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
