CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MINORU OKUDA 575 HIGHWAY 20-26 ONTARIO, OREGON 97914

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the MALHEUR RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 30.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 60.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11212. The date of priority is AUGUST 1, 1988. This right is limited to 1.13 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

(WELL 1) NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 18 S, R 46 E, W.M.; 1559.2 FEET NORTH AND 176.3 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 19;

(WELL 2) NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 18 S, R 47 E, W.M.; 1431.3 FEET NORTH AND 1331.4 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

WELL 1 SUPPLEMENTAL

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 23.0 ACRES NW 1/4 SW 1/4 37.1 ACRES

WELL 2 PRIMARY

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.9 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 28.6 ACRES

SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE AND GROUND WATER rights of others.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
