CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUTSCH BROTHERS  
ROUTE 2, BOX 139A  
WOODBURN, OREGON 97071

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 97.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 89.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5479. The date of priority is JANUARY 3, 1975. This right is limited to 1.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 5 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), SECTION 15, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM; 2720 FEET SOUTH FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
